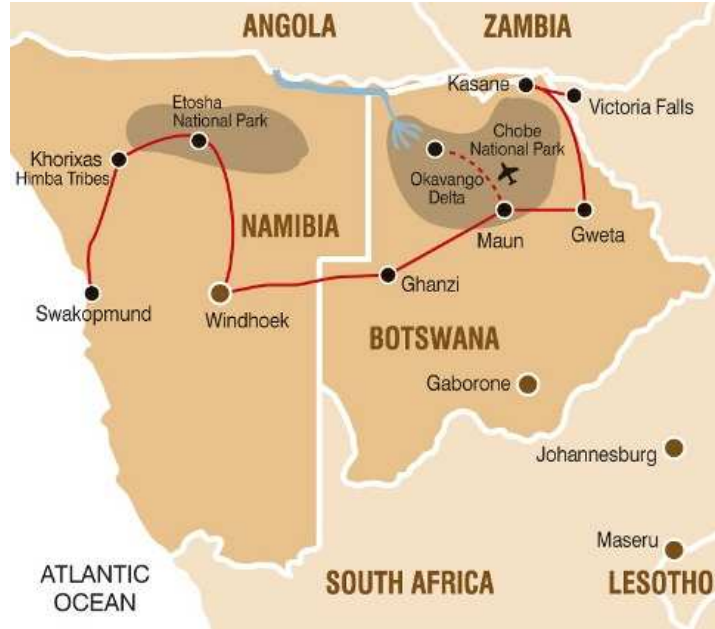


AFRICAN BUNDU SAFARIS

NASV – 13 DAY DESERT AND DELTA

Summary: This 13 day safari begins in Namibia. Starting out from the town of Swakopmund, you will travel inland towards the north west of Namibia where you will encounter a traditional Himba tribe to learn about this traditional Namibian culture. Departing Kamanjab, you will venture next into the Etosha National Park for some great animal spotting. Your tour now turns in the direction of Botswana where you will travel to Ghanzi, stopping at Windhoek on the way. Once in Botswana you will spend time in both the magnificent Okavango Delta and Chobe NP before travelling up to the mighty Victoria Falls.



Price: R13 450 with a US\$745 local payment. The Local payment is an amount that needs to be paid in cash, in the currency specified, to your guide on the morning of departure. This tour has a R3 200 compulsory single supplement.

Start/End: Swakopmund / Vic Falls

Accommodation: In rooms or permanent Safari tents – this trip is 2 per room or tent. All accommodation in Southern Africa is Twin Room, en-suite.

Departure Dates: Every Wednesday starting from the 12 January until 13 July 2011

Day 1 Swakopmund

After meeting your guides you will have the opportunity to experience one of the many optional activities available in the adventure capital of Namibia, Swakopmund. Alternatively explore the town, admire the architecture or visit the many quaint shops.

Optional Activities: Dinner, Quad biking, Sand boarding, Sky Diving, Scenic Flights etc.

Meals: Dinner

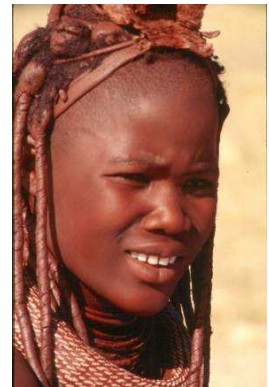

Day 2 Kamanjab - Himba Tribe

Today we head inland towards Kamanjab in the north-west of Namibia. The following morning we will spend time with some of the semi-nomadic Himba people. The Himba are a pastoral people and are easily recognisable by their unique style of hair and dress.

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Day 3/4 Etosha National Park

After our informative time spent with the Himba we travel south-east to Etosha NP. The open plains allow spectacular elevated game viewing from the truck whilst on game drives. Our quality



bungalow accommodation is inside the park at Okaukuejo and/or Halali which both boast floodlit night water holes where the animals come regularly to drink. Optional Activities: Morning or Night Drive with expert Namibian Game Ranger.

Overnight: Halali and/or Okaukuejo Lodges

Day 5 Windhoek

En-route to Namibia's capital, Windhoek, we stop at a

craft market where you can buy authentic African carvings and paintings. On arrival in Windhoek we take a short driving tour around the city, and there's some free time to explore the centre. Optional Activities: Dinner out.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Overnight: Safari Hotel



Day 6 Botswana - Ghanzi

We say goodbye to Namibia and cross the Botswana border. Later we arrive at our lodge in Ghanzi, and this evening we experience some traditional tribal dancing from the local San community.

Optional Activities: Game drive and bushman walk.

Day 7/8/9 Maun – Okavango Delta

Maun is well known as the gateway to the Okavango Delta, the world's largest inland delta. We spend one night in Maun and prepare for this excursion. Small planes transport us over this amazing area to our tented camp; Moremi Crossing. Once in the Delta animals are often spotted from the lodge, but we also take a nature walk with a local expert and a guided afternoon boat cruise. If the water level allows there will also be a traditional mokoro (dug-out canoe) trip.

Day 10 Gweta

A second scenic air-transfer will return us to Maun and the truck. This afternoon we drive to Planet Baobab where our evening accommodation is set amongst the majestic Baobab trees. For those wishing to learn more an optional Baobab Bush Walk is available. Optional Activity: Baobab Bush Walk.

Day 11 Chobe National Park

After continuing north to Kasane, we enjoy the included sunset river cruise on the Chobe River (in the National Park) where animals such as hippos, buffalo and elephants are plentiful. Optional Activities: Chobe Game Drive (next morning).

Overnight: Thebe River Lodge

Day 12 Zimbabwe - Victoria Falls

After an early morning optional game drive we cross into Zimbabwe where we have a short briefing on all the activities available here. Then we enter the much-anticipated Victoria Falls NP where we will experience the might of the great Zambezi River. Officially your tour finishes the next day after breakfast but most people will spend the day White Water Rafting, so we recommend an additional night be spent here. Optional Activities: Zambezi Sunset Cruise, Dinner out, White Water Rafting, Bungee Jump, Elephant Excursion, White Water rafting and many more...

Day 13 Victoria Falls

Most people will spend the day on one of the many activities on offer here such as a walk with lions, or a helicopter flight over the Victoria Falls. Your tour officially finishes after breakfast, but there is the option to book extra nights. Optional Activities: White Water Rafting, Bungee Jump, Elephant Excursion, White Water rafting and many more.
